# **Public Services: Public Safety** & Emergency Response



**California's Career Technical Education programs** engage students by integrating academics with career education. Knowledge and skills are learned and applied within a sequential standardsbased program designed to prepare students for technical training, post-high school education, and entry-level employment. CTE programs culminate in a capstone project and an internship, which consists of placement with local business partners where students apply their knowledge and skills they have acquired through their coursework.
